**Glenn County Solid Waste Transfer Station Construction Project**

Questions and requests received are in black, County response is in red.

1. Is there an Engineer's Estimate available for this project?

There is currently no Engineer's Estimate available for distribution. Based on draft estimates the County of Glenn Board of Supervisors has approved the project with an amount not to exceed \$4,215,999.76. This information is publicly available on the County's website and a link has been provided below.

2. The bid schedule references an Exhibit A, but there does not appear to be an Exhibit A included with the bid documents.

Consider any reference to Exhibit A to mean Drawing EX-1, titled "Bid Alternate Contractor/County Responsibility Plan". It is the color coordinated site map just before the bid schedule on PDF page 55. This exhibit was included to help clarify some of the optional work areas that may be undertaken by county forces.

3. Will alternatives to the bolted/welded tank be allowed?

Bidders can always submit an alternative with their bid, but need to include the base bid items for the bid to be considered. Any proposed alternatives must meet all applicable codes and regulations (E.g. California Building Code, California Fire Code, National Fire Protection Association).

The County would like to remind potential bidders that bid related inquiries will be received until February 8, 2018, and that the **mandatory site walk is scheduled for January 31, 2018 at 11:00 a.m.** Thank you for your consideration of our request.
