1. As listed in Section 4, PDF page 4, the RFP requires assistance with FCC licensing. Silke Communications' question is thus; "Generally how many frequencies are licensed by GCSO and PWD? And what is expected growth in new licenses in the next 5 years?"

Public Works Response:

We believe we have two frequencies assigned to Public Works by the FCC. They are 151.04000 and 156.04500 associated with call sign KXL273. We have had these two since 1989 and do not anticipate a need for more in the next 5 years.

Sherriff Office Response:

The Glenn County Sheriff's Office currently has six call signs and sixteen frequencies assigned to the department. Call signs include KNCW548, WQOE771, WPGV755, KNHG374, KNHS549, and WQNC666. There are plans to expand to a new repeater site (for a total of three) within the next 5 years which will require either modification to an existing frequency set currently assigned to that location or a new license (to be determined by successful bidder).
