REQUEST FOR QUALIFICATIONS 2022 ON-CALL ENGINEERING SERVICES

Questions and requests received are in black, County response is in red.

1. At the bottom of Page 11 of 15 of the RFQ, under the Project Understanding & Approach details, there are several references to providing discussion of perceived project challenges and to provide a scope of work tailored to the approach which would be modified during negotiations and become part of the contract/agreement. These appear to possibly indicate a specific project, whereas the various project types listed under the scope of services are wide ranging and project challenges and scope could vary greatly depending on the actual assigned project. Or is the County simply looking for an overall generic approach to similar on-call contracts and a broad, comprehensive scope of work outline which could be refined and detailed out depending on the actual assigned project?

The County is looking for an overall approach to on-call contracts, highlight past experience that is similar in nature to the tasks outlined in the scope of work.

2. Some typical county CIP projects include architectural services, say, for general, buildings, or parks categories projects. Are any architectural services included in this rfp?

Architectural services are not part of the scope of this Request for Qualifications.
